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Editorial

What is unlearning? Quoting from an article of Albert P'Rayan; an academic, education columnist and media critic, "Unlearning is the process of realising that something which we learnt earlier is incorrect, ineffective, or obsolete, admitting it and deciding to erase such bad conditioning and misconceptions from our mind for good. It is the process of exploring what we have stored in our system and deleting all the unnecessary data. It is the process of saying bye to an old, obsolete, and outdated paradigm, and embracing a new paradigm and willingly undergoing a paradigm shift."

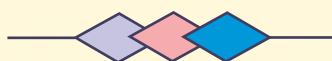
Unfortunately what happens is, most people have a fixed mindset and their thinking and behaviour is governed by certain preconceived notions, myths, false assumptions and wrong opinions, and are not open to new ideas and are unwilling to relook their mode of thinking and behaviour and see the reality. Adding to that with the social media playing a pivotal role in our gathering information, certain myths become viral and many tend to believe them as truth.

According to Alvin Toffler, a futurist and a philosopher "*The illiterate of the future are not those who can't read or write but those who cannot learn, unlearn and relearn .*"

Good Teachers, as educators, who constantly unlearn are able to enable their students to learn to unlearn. But unfortunately, the need for "unlearning" is not emphasised, as many are really not interested in unlearning what they have learnt. Many a senior teachers think that they know everything, as they have many years of teaching experience and are quite happy with the teaching methods and think they don't need to learn any new skills, given that at the end of the year the teaching-learning outcome is measured by marks which is easily obtained by rote memory, and may use it, to justify ineffective teaching practices.

It is not only teachers, all the more we as educators and leaders need to 'learn to unlearn' as it is the first step towards acquiring real knowledge, as according to the renowned Chinese Taoist philosopher, Lao Tzu, "To attain knowledge, add things every day. To attain wisdom, remove things every day".

Provincial's Message

The "Wisdom" Spirituality of St. Louis Marie de Montfort is in essence addressing these fundamental questions that, Can we love someone we do not even know? Can we love deeply someone we know only vaguely? (LEW 8)... To know Jesus Christ incarnate Wisdom, is to know all we need. To presume to know everything and not know Him is to know nothing at all. (LEW 11)



Here, St. Louis Marie is referring to the only worthwhile knowledge, the only wisdom which can truly give meaning to our lives. He acknowledges that there are other forms of so-called "wisdom" - the "wisdom of the world", or "natural wisdom" - but believes that these can never lead to real happiness (LEW chapter 7). God's wisdom, revealed to us in Jesus Christ, alone is able to do that. And so he sees Jesus Christ as the personification of that wisdom of God, which is "eternal" and "incarnate". And, if we wish to achieve real happiness we need to "acquire" this wisdom - to come to know Jesus Christ and to love him and commit ourselves to a Brotherly relationship with him.

Trust in Divine Providence At the age of nineteen, a new chapter opens in Montfort's life. The young man bade good-bye to family and friends at the bridge of Cesson on the outskirts of the city of Rennes. The event takes on great symbolism. Having left all, he crossed the Cesson bridge to a new life of total dependence on Divine Providence. So convinced was he that God is truly his loving Father, that he gave to the first beggars he met, his money, baggage and even exchanged clothes with one of them with a joyful and total abandonment.

He gave free expression to his deep desire to experience the radical demands of the Gospel. Begging for food and shelter along the way, he walked to Paris, arriving in the rags of a mendicant. He was beginning to find his freedom in a total surrender to God's Love, the Incarnate and Eternal Wisdom, Jesus the Lord.

St. Louis Marie de Montfort wrote in a letter to his uncle, Abbé Alain Robert, in September 1694: "Whatever happens I shall not be worried. I have a Father in heaven who will never fail me." This expresses perfectly his attitude of total trust in the Providence of God, which was the characteristic that he exhibited in his whole life. God was his Father, who would never fail to provide him with all that he needed to live fully as a human being and as a priest.

This attitude, of course, requires a very strong faith, a faith that is based on an awareness of the tremendous love that God has for human beings - a love which St Louis Marie writes about especially in The Love of Eternal Wisdom. It is the same kind of faith expressed by St. Paul when he says (in Rm 8:28): "We know that in everything God works good for those who love Him."

Lover . . . of the Poor Saint Louis-Marie identified with the poor and found his greatest joy in serving them with the Word of God. Serving them with any material help he could locate.

Typical of his actions was the recorded event probably one of many similar acts on his part when the saint tenderly embraced a dying leprous beggar lying in the streets of Dinan, carried him to a nearby religious house and cried out to the doorkeeper, "Open up to Jesus Christ." The poor even took up a collection to purchase some warm clothing for this priest whom they proudly called "one

of their own."

To the majority of the people, Louis Grignion was "the good Father from Montfort" or "the Father with the big rosary. His preaching, flowing from his own experience of God's love and Mary's maternal care, attracted thousands back to the faith. His goal was also becoming more precise: to be a missionary either in France or abroad. He yearned to proclaim the Good News to the poor. To proclaim to the outcasts, to tell them of the love of Jesus and of the maternal care of Mary. He was called the Apostolic Missionary by Pope Clement IX. Let us strive to be worthy disciples of this Apostolic Missionary by seeking at all times the Wisdom of God, Trusting in Divine Providence and doing everything as a Lover of the Poor.

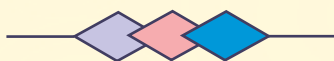
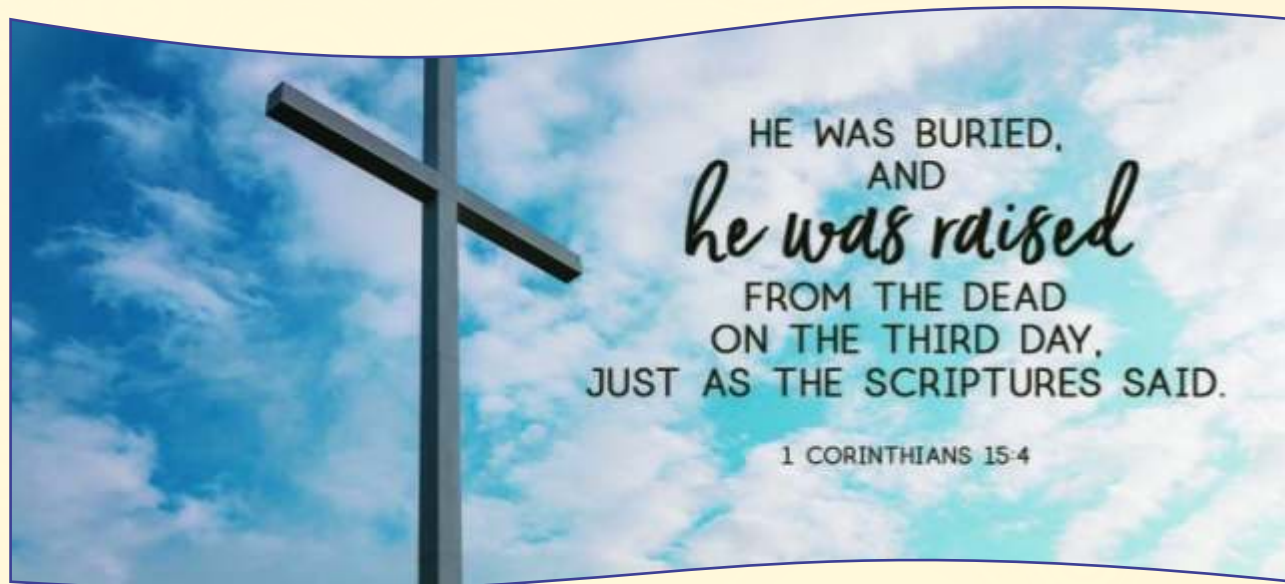
To sum up this academic year 2022-23 was effective and perfect with new innovative attempts, extra efforts and rewarding results beautiful awaking thoughts.....

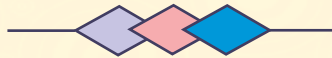


Parents - Teachers Meeting

K.G. GRADUATION DAY:

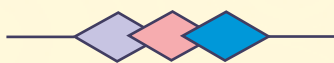

PHYSICAL HEALTH & FITNESS:

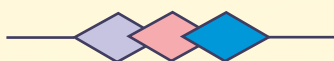

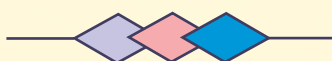


INVESTITURE CEREMONY 2023: 2024

Graduation Day:

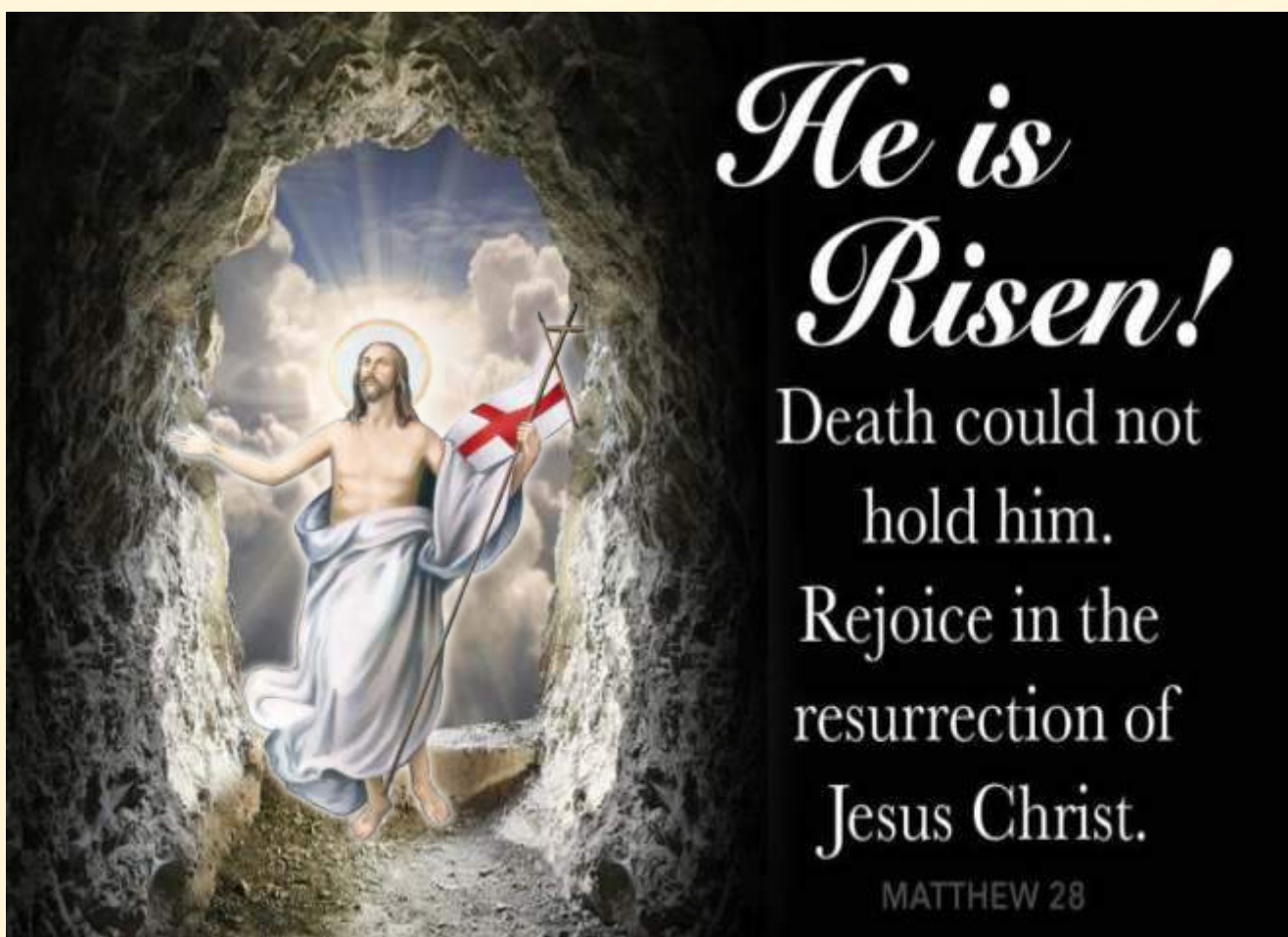
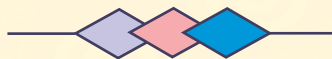
